CHARACTERISTICS OF AP PSYCHOLOGY STUDENTS

CHARACTERISTICS OF AN "A" STUDENT:

- Motivated to excel!
- Reads entire chapter carefully for comprehension
- Reads the assignments when they are assigned, not at the end of the unit
- Takes notes, highlights, and listens carefully
- Studies notes, outlines and reading as we proceed through the chapter
- Completes all homework even if it is not going to be collected for a grade
- Written assignments are thorough and answer the question completely
- Actively participates in class discussions especially asks questions
- Focused on activities, discussions, and the material
- Writes well with very few spelling and grammar errors
- Test & quiz grades are consistently high
- Neat and well organized does **not** procrastinate
- *Never quite satisfied with their work*

CHARACTERISTICS OF A "B" STUDENT:

- Wants a good grade, but doesn't work quite as hard
- Reads the chapter, but not as carefully not for comprehension, just for the key terms
- Reads assignment, but not until the end of the unit just before the test
- Does not take notes depends on "listening carefully"
- Completes homework if it is going to be collected
- Written answers cover the minimum necessary to complete the assignment
- Participates in discussion when asked
- Usually focused on activities, discussions, and the material
- Writes well, but has minor spelling and grammar errors
- Test & quiz grades fluctuate sometimes high and sometimes low
- Not well organized, although can usually find things
- *Makes excuses for things not done frequently procrastinates*

CHARACTERISTICS OF A "C" STUDENT:

- Satisfied with "good enough"
- Reads some of the chapter, or doesn't read it carefully mostly skims the reading
- Depends on unit outline too much without adding examples and clarifications
- Does not take notes depends on "listening carefully", but sometimes doesn't do that
- Does not complete all homework
- Written answers are frequently incomplete or only cover the minimum
- Very rarely participates in discussion
- Easily distracted or off the subject, plays on Chromebook or phone during class
- Writing contains many spelling and grammar errors
- Test grades usually low
- Not well organized, frequently loses or forgets assignments
- Procrastinates assignments rarely handed in on time
- Works on other homework in class
- Makes excuses
